

MEDICAL INSURANCE FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS IN POLAND

Get insured with the International Student Identity Card (ISIC)

The insurance covers:

- treatment in case of a sudden illness or accident
- cost of hospital stay, in-patient treatment and surgical procedures
- cost of transportation to a hospital or to the place of residence
